## **About Ummeed:**

Ummeed is a non-profit organization providing family-centered care to children with developmental disabilities and their families. Being on the School Outreach Team will give you the opportunity to advocate and work towards creating/ promoting an inclusive environment in schools so that they are conducive to children with varied needs and abilities.

- Strategize and support School Outreach program/ project towards promoting inclusion in different school systems
- Contribute to the planning and growth of School Outreach program by liaising with different types of schools/ educators within the space of education
- Be a Program Manager for conducting activities specific to School Outreach Program
- Be an advocate for children with varied learning needs/ disabilities and their families within the school system and in the community

• 2 to 5 years of teaching experience in a school
